## Fiscal Responsibility Challenge

Why is that? Why can't political races be about the issues, the ideas, and leadership? Instead it's about political connections, and fundraising.

Is that how you want it? Do you want the candidates with the most money to always win? I know I don't. As I see it, if the person who wins is the one who spends the most money, then who's to say that when they take office they won't have the same mentality. Spend. Spend. Spend. And in this economy, can we afford that?

Instead, I am taking a different approach. I have decided to spend as little as possible and run my campaign with the same fiscal responsibility I will take to Congress. I believe we need to cut our spending in Washington, work off a budget, and pay down our debt. So unlike my competitors, I won't be throwing big money at every media opportunity that comes my way. I will be much more focused in my media approach and ultimately get down to true grass roots campaigning, which means knocking on doors, being in the community, utilizing social media, and sitting down face to face with one voter at a time.
